



JOB DESCRIPTION: LABOURER

Overview

General labourers are responsible for aiding in all areas of the precast plant. They are responsible for collecting materials, assembling cages, setting up forms and concrete placing. They participate in general housekeeping and other various tasks throughout the plant.

Responsibilities

- Receive oral instructions to determine work assignments.
- Perform physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials
- Position or dismantle forms for pouring concrete
- Transport raw materials, finished products and equipment throughout plant manually or using powered equipment
- Assist machine operators, assemblers and other workers
- Bending of reinforcing steel for precast concrete structures
- May assist with minor repairs and maintenance
- Remove rubble and other debris
- Clean and remove excess debris from molds and other equipment
- Participate in daily Pre-Production Meetings
- Complete Field Level Risk Assessments before beginning each task
